

## Elementary Dress Code Pre-Kindergarten through Sixth Grade

### Both:

- Acceptable colors for pants, capri's or shorts are blue jean, black, khaki and navy and must be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck. Holes, tears, frayed hems or appliqués are ***not*** acceptable.
- Pants must fit well, not oversized, baggy, or “high” water pants (too short having out grown).
- Shorts must be the long style just above the knee.
- Logos that are not offensive (determined by administration) may be worn.
- Official RCS T-shirts may be worn on Friday.
- No hunting or military camouflage patterns.
- Shirts must have collars or turtlenecks unless girls are in skirts.
- No “over shirts” such as sports jerseys are allowed.
- No flip-flops, all shoes must have a back strap.
- No hats worn in classroom or any building. May be worn outside for warmth or protection from the sun.
- No artificial hair coloring.

### Boys:

- Shirts must be tucked in while on school grounds.
- No necklaces or earrings. Watches may be worn but not bracelets.
- Hair should be neatly trimmed to mid-ear, above the collar in the back and not touching the eyebrows in the front.

### Girls:

- Dresses and skirts may be worn with appropriate non-collared tops.
- Dresses and skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Spaghetti strap dresses are not allowed without a shirt underneath.
- 2” wide straps acceptable for dresses or shirts.
- Tops should reach the waist when arms are raised straight up (no tummies showing.)
- Tight or form fitting tops or pants are not allowed.
- Girls should wear shorts under their dresses if they are going to be playing on the play equipment.
- No make-up.
- Earrings limited to one set of post style or small hoops.
- No platforms or high heel shoes. On P.E. days girls **must** have tennis shoes.
