

Redding Christian Dress Code

Junior High and High School

The purpose of a dress code in a Christian School is to exemplify standards of appearance that reflect human dignity as God’s image-bearers on earth. The RCS standards of dress and grooming are in keeping with the high Christian ideals we seek to establish in those who attend our school. We have set a moderate age-appropriate tone, avoiding the extremes of both legalism and liberalism. There are four components the School Board considers when setting guidelines for grooming standards. 1) The issue of modesty; 2) The issue of safety in class and on the campus; 3) The way RCS staff and students represent Godly character to the community; and 4) Student attire being conducive to a serious academic environment.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subtle, natural colored highlights in hair. • Hair neatly trimmed above a dress shirt collar in the back • Hair should be clean, neat and styled so it does not affect the vision or prevent the teacher from having eye contact • Collared shirt/colored T-shirt • Docker style pants • Solid colored pants or jeans 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shaved head • Extreme styles • Facial hair • Sideburns below the earlobe. • Make up • Earrings • <i>Inappropriate/excessive accessories</i> • Body piercing • Plain white T-shirt • Untucked shirts hanging past student’s wrist

GIRLS

ACCEPTABLE	UNACCEPTABLE
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Subtle, natural colored highlights in hair• Hair should be clean, neat and styled so it does not effect the vision or prevent the teacher from having eye contact• Two earrings worn in each lobe• Skirts/dresses to the knee• Skirts/dress slits no higher than to the knee• Dresses/blouses with 2” wide strap• Jeans	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Extreme styles• Accessories or make-up that is not a positive reflection on RCS• Body piercing other than the ear• Spaghetti Strap• Earrings anywhere but the ear lobe• Midriffs showing• Cleavage exposed• Bra straps showing• Tight or form fitting tops
